- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene for purposes
- 5 of making capitation payments for services provided to Maryland Medicaid Program
- 6 recipients enrolled in managed care organizations to implement a certain capitation
- 7 payment system to assure that the graduate medical education component of the
- 8 capitated rates is used only to reimburse certain persons that have graduate medical
- 9 education costs included in rates approved by the Health Services Cost Review
- 10 Commission under certain circumstances.

27 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 28 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 15-103(b)(26) and (27), respectively, of Article Health
- 29 General of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s)

- 5 (b) (1) As permitted by federal law or waiver, the Secretary may establish a
- 6 program under which Program recipients are required to enroll in managed care
- 7 organizations.
- 8 (26) (I) FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING CAPITATION PAYMENTS FOR
- 9 SERVICES PROVIDED TO PROGRAM RECIPIENTS ENROLLED IN MANAGED CARE
- 10 ORGANIZATIONS, THE SECRETARY SHALL IMPLEMENT A CAPITATION PAYMENT
- 11 SYSTEM TO ASSURE THAT THE GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION COMPONENT OF
- 12 THE CAPITATED RATES IS USED ONLY TO REIMBURSE THE GRADUATE MEDICAL
- 13 EDUCATION COSTS OF FACILITIES THAT HAVE GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION
- 14 COSTS INCLUDED IN THE RATES APPROVED BY THE HEALTH SERVICES COST
- 15 REVIEW COMMISSION.
- 16 (II) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE COSTS OF
- 17 GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION TO BE REIMBURSED SHALL BE BASED ON THE
- 18 METHODOLOGY DETERMINED BY THE HEALTH SERVICES COST REVIEW
- 19 COMMISSION AND AS AUTHORIZED AND INCLUDED IN RATES APPROVED BY THE
- 20 HEALTH SERVICES COST REVIEW COMMISSION.
