CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

Hair Braiding Services - Exemption from Licensure 2

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a license to provide hair braiding services; defining hair

4 braiding services; specifying the qualifications of an applicant for a license to

5 provide hair braiding services; specifying the scope of practice of the license;

6 clarifying the scope of the practice of cosmetology; providing for a beauty salon

permit for a beauty salon that provides only hair braiding services; setting standards 7

8 for apprenticeships in hair braiding; excluding from the scope of licensure certain

9 hair braiding services; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally

10 relating to hair braiding and cosmetology in the State.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
