3 **(Numbers of Licenses)**

5 FOR the purpose of altering the number of certain classes of alcoholic beverages permits  
6 in Prince George's County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Prince  
7 George's County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
10 Section 9-217(b)(2), (6), and (12)  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (1996 Replacement Volume)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 9-217.

17 (b) The number of licenses of each class of alcoholic beverage licenses may not  
18 exceed the following maximum amounts:

- 19 (2) Beer license, Class B.....[17 ] 23
- 20 (6) Beer and light wine license, Class B.....[35] 38
- 21 (12) Beer, wine and liquor license, Class B.....[164] 170
