BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions** 16 12-607. 17 (a) (1) In this subsection, "officer" includes a superintendent, manager, and 18 agent of a corporation regardless of whether it engages in the business of providing plumbing services. 20 (2) A person, including an officer, who violates any provision of the 21 following sections of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject 22 to a fine not exceeding \$50 for each day or part of each day that the violation continues: 23 (i) § 12-602; 24 (ii) § 12-603; and 25 (iii) § 12-604. 26 (b) A person who violates any provision of the following sections of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$100 or

28 imprisonment not exceeding 6 months or both for each day or part of each day that the

29 violation continues:

2 1 (1) § 12-601; 2 (2) § 12-605; and 3 (3) § 12-606. 4 (c) Any person who knowingly and willfully violates any provision of § 12-501(a) 5 of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding 6 \$1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 6 months or both. (D) (1) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTIES UNDER THIS TITLE, A 7 8 PERSON WHO VIOLATES § 12-601 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL FINE, 9 IMPOSED BY THE BOARD, NOT TO EXCEED \$5,000 FOR EACH DAY OR PART OF A DAY 10 THAT A VIOLATION CONTINUES. (2) IN DETERMINING THE APPROPRIATE AMOUNT OF A FINE IMPOSED 11 12 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD SHALL CONSIDER: 13 (I) THE GRAVITY OF THE VIOLATION; (II) THE GOOD FAITH OF THE VIOLATOR; 14 15 (III) THE QUANTITY AND GRAVITY OF PREVIOUS VIOLATIONS BY 16 THE SAME VIOLATOR: 17 (IV) THE HARM CAUSED TO THE COMPLAINANT, THE PUBLIC, AND 18 THE PLUMBING PROFESSION; 19 (V) THE ASSETS OF THE VIOLATOR; AND

(VI) ANY OTHER FACTORS THAT THE BOARD CONSIDERS
