- 8 (F) (1) WHENEVER NATURAL RESOURCES POLICE OFFICERS RECEIVE A
- 9 SALARY INCREASE, FOREST AND PARK RANGERS IN THE STATE FOREST AND PARK
- 10 SERVICE SHALL RECEIVE A SALARY INCREASE IN THE SAME PERCENTAGE AS THE
- 11 SALARY INCREASE RECEIVED BY NATURAL RESOURCES POLICE OFFICERS.
- 12 (2) WHENEVER NATURAL RESOURCES POLICE OFFICERS RECEIVE A
- 13 GRADE OR STEP INCREASE, FOREST AND PARK RANGERS IN THE STATE FOREST
- 14 AND PARK SERVICE SHALL RECEIVE AN EQUAL GRADE OR STEP INCREASE.
- 15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 July 1, 1997.
