- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to distribute to Prince George's County
- and Montgomery County in a certain manner the net income tax revenue for a 5
- certain taxable year attributable to the county income tax paid by certain residents 6
- 7 of the City of Takoma Park; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally
- 8 relating to the distribution of the net income tax revenue for a certain taxable year
- attributable to the county income tax paid by certain residents of the City of 9
- 10 Takoma Park.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 12 MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding the provisions of §§ 2-608 and 10-103(a) of the Tax
- 13 General Article, of the net income tax revenue for the 1997 taxable year attributable to
- 14 the county income tax paid by residents of that part of the City of Takoma Park that until
- 15 July 1, 1997 will be a part of Prince George's County, the Comptroller shall distribute
- 16 one-half to Prince George's County and one-half to Montgomery County.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 17
- 18 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has
- 19 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
- 20 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
- 21 enacted.
