A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Protection of Marriages

3 FOR the purpose of specifying that a marriage between two consenting adults is valid in

- 4 the State; altering the definition of a "foreign marriage"; and generally relating to
- 5 the validity of marriages in the State.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 7 Article Family Law
- 8 Section 2-201 and 2-502(a)
- 9 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 10 (1991 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Family Law

14 2-201.

15	(A) Only a marriage between [a man and a woman] TWO CONSENTING ADULTS
16	is valid in this State.

17 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT INVALIDATE ANY OTHER SECTIONS IN THIS18 TITLE.

19 2-502.

- 20 (a) In this section, "foreign marriage" means a marriage ceremony:
- 21 (1) performed outside this State; [and]
- 22 (2) BETWEEN TWO CONSENTING ADULTS; AND
- 23 [(2)] (3) in which [1] ONE or both of the parties were or are citizens of this

24 State.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 1997.
