4 FOR the purpose of creating a special Class D on-sale beer and wine license in St. Mary's
5 County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in St. Mary's County.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

14 7-101.

15 (r) (4) (I) THERE IS A SPECIAL CLASS D (ON-SALE) BEER AND WINE
16 LICENSE WHICH MAY BE ISSUED TO ANY BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS, FRATERNAL, CIVIC,
17 VETERANS', HOSPITAL, OR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION.

18 (II) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED FOR A ONE-DAY PERIOD.

19 (III) THE FEE FOR EACH LICENSE IS \$10.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 1997.
