- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Maryland Higher Education Commission to
- 4 administer oaths and to issue certain subpoenas; requiring the Chairperson of the
- 5 Commission to sign certain subpoenas; authorizing a circuit court to compel
- 6 compliance with a subpoena issued by the Commission; and generally relating to the
- 7 enforcement powers of the Maryland Higher Education Commission.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Education
- 16 11-108.
- 17 (A) THE COMMISSION MAY ADMINISTER OATHS.
- 18 (B) (1) THE COMMISSION MAY ISSUE A SUBPOENA FOR THE ATTENDANCE
- 19 OF A WITNESS TO TESTIFY OR FOR THE PRODUCTION OF EVIDENCE IN CONNECTION
- 20 WITH A PROCEEDING BROUGHT FOR AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE.
- 21 (2) A SUBPOENA SHALL BE SIGNED BY THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE
- 22 COMMISSION.
- 23 (C) IF A PERSON FAILS TO COMPLY WITH A SUBPOENA ISSUED UNDER THIS
- 24 SECTION, ON PETITION OF THE COMMISSION, A CIRCUIT COURT MAY COMPEL
- 25 COMPLIANCE WITH THE SUBPOENA.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 1997.
