2 **Prince George's County - Nonschool Use of School Facilities - Local Regulation**

3 **PG 417-97**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing local regulation of nonschool use of school facilities for
5 certain purposes in Prince George's County subject to certain conditions;
6 authorizing a certain local law to contain certain provisions; making certain stylistic
7 changes; and generally relating to the local regulation of nonschool use of school
8 facilities in Prince George's County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article - Education**

22 7-108.

23 (f) (1) In Montgomery County, nonschool use of school facilities for public and
24 community purposes and the manner by which costs associated with such use are
25 apportioned may be regulated by local law consistent with the use criteria set forth in §
26 7-110 and not inconsistent with any other provisions of this article.

27 (2) The local law authorized by this subsection may provide for an
28 interagency coordinating board and for the appointment of its members by Montgomery
29 County.

1 (3) [Membership] THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE INTERAGENCY
2 COORDINATING BOARD may include the Superintendent of Schools, the President of
3 Montgomery College, the members of the Montgomery County Planning Board, and
4 [such] ANY other members as may be provided by the local law.

5 (G) (1) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, NONSCHOOL USE OF SCHOOL
6 FACILITIES FOR PUBLIC AND COMMUNITY PURPOSES, AND THE MANNER IN WHICH
7 THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE ARE APPORTIONED, MAY BE REGULATED BY
8 LOCAL LAW CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CRITERIA SET FORTH IN § 7-110 OF THIS
9 SUBTITLE AND NOT INCONSISTENT WITH ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE.

10 (2) THE LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZED BY THIS SUBSECTION MAY PROVIDE
11 FOR AN INTERAGENCY COORDINATING BOARD AND THE APPOINTMENT OF ITS
12 MEMBERS.

13 (3) THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE INTERAGENCY COORDINATING BOARD
14 MAY INCLUDE THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE
15 PRESIDENT OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COMMUNITY COLLEGE, THE MEMBERS OF THE
16 PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY PLANNING BOARD, AND ANY OTHER MEMBERS THAT
17 MAY BE PROVIDED BY THE LOCAL LAW.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 1997.
