- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 (f) (1) In Montgomery County, nonschool use of school facilities for public and
- 24 community purposes and the manner by which costs associated with such use are
- 25 apportioned may be regulated by local law consistent with the use criteria set forth in §
- 26 7-110 and not inconsistent with any other provisions of this article.
- 27 (2) The local law authorized by this subsection may provide for an
- 28 interagency coordinating board and for the appointment of its members by Montgomery
- 29 County.

- 14 MAY INCLUDE THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE
- 15 PRESIDENT OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COMMUNITY COLLEGE, THE MEMBERS OF THE
