1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County Board of Education - Vacancy - Election of Members**3 **PG 408-97**

4 FOR the purpose of altering a certain procedure for the filling of a vacancy on the Prince
5 George's County Board of Education; specifying a certain term of office; making
6 certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to the filling of a vacancy on the
7 Prince George's County Board of Education.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 3-1002.

17 (g) (1) Each elected member serves for a term of 4 years beginning on the first
18 Monday in December after [his] THE MEMBER'S election and until [his] THE
19 MEMBER'S successor is elected and qualifies. The terms of members are staggered as
20 required by the terms of the members serving on the County Board as of July 1, 1978.

21 (2) The student member serves for a term of 1 year beginning at the end of
22 a school year.

23 (3) (I) Subject to the confirmation of the County Council, the County
24 Executive of Prince George's County shall appoint a qualified individual to fill any
25 vacancy on the County Board [for the remainder of that term and] until a successor is
26 elected and qualifies AT A SPECIAL ELECTION WITHIN 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF
27 THE VACANCY OR AT THE NEXT CONGRESSIONAL ELECTION, WHICHEVER OCCURS
28 FIRST.

29 (II) THE SUCCESSOR SHALL SERVE THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM
30 FOR WHICH THE VACANCY IS BEING FILLED.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 1997.
