- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 **Article Education**
- 17 3-1004.
- 18 (a) The County Board shall hold an annual meeting on the first Monday in
- 19 December to elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its members.
- 20 (b) All actions of the County Board shall be taken at a public meeting and a
- 21 record of the meeting and all actions shall be made public.
- 22 (c) This section does not prohibit the County Board from meeting and
- 23 deliberating in executive session provided that all action of the Board, together with the
- 24 individual vote of each member, is contained in a public record.
- 25 (D) (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
- 26 SUBSECTION. THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD
- 27 FOR THE PASSAGE OF A MOTION BY THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE:
- 28 (I) SIX MEMBERS WHEN THE STUDENT MEMBER IS VOTING; OR

- $3\,$ BOARD FOR THE PASSAGE OF A MOTION BY THE BOARD SHALL BE FIVE MEMBERS.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
