14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

17 (g) (1) The Board shall appoint [a clerk] AN ADMINISTRATOR.

18 (2) The [clerk] ADMINISTRATOR shall carry out the duties assigned by the
19 Board.20 (3) The County Commissioners shall set the salary of the [clerk]
21 ADMINISTRATOR.22 (4) The County Commissioners may assign clerical assistance as is necessary
23 to carry out the duties of the Board.24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the person who holds the
25 position of Clerk to the Board of License Commissioners on October 1, 1997, shall
26 continue and be in the position of Administrator to the Board.27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
28 October 1, 1997.
