1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County - Electrician Licenses - Examinations**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the passing grade of an examination to qualify for a Master

4 Electrician license in Washington County.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

6 The Public Local Laws of Washington County

7 Section 8-106(a)(1)

8 Article 22 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

9 (1991 Edition and August 1994 Supplement, as amended)

10 (As enacted by Chapter 295 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1996)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 22 - Washington County**

14 8-106.

15 (a) (1) (i) Before any individual engages in the business of a Master

16 Electrician in Washington County, that individual shall apply to the Board for a license

17 examination.

18 (ii) The Board shall hold license examinations 4 times annually at a

19 time and place determined by the Board.

20 (iii) An applicant shall file a license application with work experience

21 verification letters and an examination fee of \$50 at least 30 days before the examination

22 date. The examination fee is not refundable.

1 (iv) An applicant shall take and pass an objective written examination  
2 to determine fitness for a license.

3 (v) The passing grade for the examination shall be [75] 70 percent.

4 (vi) The examination shall require knowledge of all applicable codes,  
5 laws, rules, and principles of electrical installations.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 October 1, 1997.
