## 2 Football Stadium at Camden Yards - Lottery Funding Deficiency

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring any revenue derived from the sale, lease, or other use of
- 4 the name of a certain professional football stadium, which is needed to offset any
- 5 deficiency in State lottery proceeds for funding stadium construction costs, to
- 6 accrue to the Maryland Stadium Authority for a certain use; requiring the Authority
- 7 to make a certain determination; and generally relating to funding for a certain
- 8 football stadium.
- 9 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 21 Article - Financial Institutions

- 23 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 24 (b) "Authority" means the Maryland Stadium Authority.
- 25 13-725.
- 26 ANY REVENUE DERIVED FROM THE SALE, LEASE, OR OTHER USE OF THE
- 27 NAME OF ANY PROFESSIONAL FOOTBALL STADIUM CONSTRUCTED AT CAMDEN
- 28 YARDS IN BALTIMORE CITY WHICH, IN AN AMOUNT DETERMINED BY THE
- 29 AUTHORITY, IS NEEDED TO OFFSET ANY DEFICIENCY IN STATE LOTTERY PROCEEDS

- $1\,$  FOR FUNDING THE CONSTRUCTION COSTS OF THE STADIUM SHALL ACCRUE TO THE
- 2 AUTHORITY FOR USE BY THE AUTHORITY TO OFFSET THE DEFICIENCY.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 October 1, 1997.
