- 31 (4) DEVELOP CRITERIA FOR ANNOUNCED AND UNANNOUNCED
- 32 INSPECTIONS AND EVALUATIONS OF COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS
- 33 AND FACILITIES BY THE STATE AGENCIES;
- 34 (5) ESTABLISH QUALIFICATIONS AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS
- 35 AMONG THE STATE AGENCIES FOR DIRECT CARE STAFF OF PERSONS HOLDING A
- 36 LICENSE TO OPERATE A COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM OR FACILITY
- 37 FOR ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES OR MENTAL DISORDERS;

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- 1 (6) PERIODICALLY REVIEW THE RESIDENTIAL PLACEMENT DECISION
- 2 PROCEDURES OF THE STATE AGENCIES FOR ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL

- 4 (7) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE APPROPRIATE STATE AGENCY
- 5 ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE
