- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (a) The Commissioner may administer oaths, depose witnesses, and certify to 20 official acts.
- 21 (b) The Commissioner may issue subpoenas for the attendance of witnesses to
- 22 testify or to produce evidence.
- 23 (c) In addition to any duties set forth elsewhere, the Commissioner shall establish
- 24 procedures necessary for reporting and keeping records to carry out the duties of the
- 25 Commissioner under this title.
- 26 (D) (1) THE COMMISSIONER MAY DEVELOP EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS,
- 27 PROGRAMS, AND POLICIES FOR THE PREVENTION OF ACCIDENTS AND INJURIES
- 28 INVOLVING THE OPERATORS AND USERS OF AMUSEMENT ATTRACTIONS AND
