A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education - State Scholarships - Foreign Study**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the use of a scholarship, grant, or loan issued under Title
4 18 of the Education Article to pay for tuition, fees, room and board, or other
5 expenses for an educational program at a foreign educational institution; providing
6 a delayed effective date; and generally relating to student financial assistance for
7 higher education.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 18-103.

17 (A) A scholarship, grant, or loan issued under this title may be used at any public
18 or private institution of higher education in this State that possesses a certificate of
19 approval from the Maryland Higher Education Commission.

20 (B) A SCHOLARSHIP, GRANT, OR LOAN ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE MAY NOT
21 BE USED TO PAY TUITION, FEES, ROOM AND BOARD, OR OTHER EXPENSES FOR AN
22 EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM CONDUCTED AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION
23 IN ANOTHER COUNTRY.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 July 1, 2000.
