2 Higher Education - State Scholarships - Foreign Study

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the use of a scholarship, grant, or loan issued under Title

- 4 18 of the Education Article to pay for tuition, fees, room and board, or other
- 5 expenses for an educational program at a foreign educational institution; providing
- 6 a delayed effective date; and generally relating to student financial assistance for

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - Education

16 18-103.

(A) A scholarship, grant, or loan issued under this title may be used at any publicor private institution of higher education in this State that possesses a certificate ofapproval from the Maryland Higher Education Commission.

(B) A SCHOLARSHIP, GRANT, OR LOAN ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE MAY NOT
BE USED TO PAY TUITION, FEES, ROOM AND BOARD, OR OTHER EXPENSES FOR AN
EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM CONDUCTED AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION
IN ANOTHER COUNTRY.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 July 1, 2000.
