- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Education
- 19 7-301.
- 20 (f) A child may be exempted from attending kindergarten if a parent or guardian
- 21 of the child files a written request with the local school system and verifies that the child
- 22 is enrolled:
- 23 (1) Full time in a licensed child care center;
- 24 (2) Full time in a registered family day care home; or
- 25 (3) Part time in a Head Start 5 year old program.
- 26 Chapter 463 of the Acts of 1991, as amended by Chapter 312 of the Acts of 1994
- 27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That § 7-301(f) of the
- 28 Education Article as enacted by this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992. [It shall remain

- 1 effective for a period of 5 years, and at the end of July 1, 1997, and with no further action 2 required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 June 1, 1997.
