A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County - Subdivision Regulations - Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying the authority for provisions regulating subdivisions in St.
4 Mary's County.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
6 The Public Local Laws of St. Mary's County
7 Section 127-1
8 Article 19 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
9 (1978 Edition and July 1996 Supplement, as amended)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article 19 - St. Mary's County**

13 127-1.

14 A. The Board of County Commissioners may prepare regulations and
15 amendments to them governing the subdivision of land within the county.

16 B. [The] IN ADDITION TO PROVISIONS AUTHORIZED BY ARTICLE 66B, § 5.03
17 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, THE regulations may provide for:

18 (1) The harmonious development of the district.

19 (2) The coordination of roads within the subdivision with other existing
20 planned or platted roads or with other features of the county or with the Commission's
21 general plan.

22 (3) Adequate open spaces for traffic, recreation, light and air, by dedication
23 or otherwise, and the dedication to public use or conveyance of areas designated for
24 dedication under the provisions of zoning regulations relating to average lot size or
25 planned community subdivisions and for the payment of a monetary fee, in lieu of
26 dedication, to enable the Commission to purchase, develop or maintain park sites for the
27 use and benefit of the subdivisions in cases where dedication would be impractical. The
28 Commissioners shall establish the monetary fee by resolution on a per-unit or per-lot
29 basis.

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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 1997.
