1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Business Occupations - State Board of Cosmetologists - Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of ~~altering the number of members on the State Board of~~  
4 ~~Cosmetologists~~; requiring one member of the State Board of Cosmetologists to be  
5 affiliated with a private cosmetology school as an educator or owner; making  
6 stylistic changes; and generally relating to the membership of the State Board of  
7 Cosmetologists.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article - Business Occupations and Professions  
10 Section 5-202(a)  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

16 5-202.

17 (a) (1) The Board consists of [5] ~~SIX FIVE~~ members.

18 (2) Of the [5] ~~SIX FIVE~~ members of the Board:

19 (i) [3] ~~THREE TWO~~ shall be licensed cosmetologists; [and]

1 (II) ONE SHALL BE AFFILIATED WITH A PRIVATE COSMETOLOGY  
2 SCHOOL AS AN EDUCATOR OR OWNER; AND

3 [(ii)] (III) [2] TWO shall be consumer members.

4 (3) The Governor shall appoint the members with the advice of the  
5 Secretary.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 October 1, 1997.
