## 2 **Podiatrists - Scope of Practice**

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the scope of practice for a licensed podiatrist by repealing
- 4 practice exclusions for triple arthrodesis, ankle fusions, and the surgical treatment
- of ankle trauma, but excluding the surgical treatment of acute ankle fracture; and
- 6 generally relating to the scope of practice for podiatry.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 14 Article - Health Occupations

- 16 (f) (1) "Practice podiatry" means to diagnose or surgically, medically, or
- 17 mechanically treat any ailment of the human foot or ankle, or any ailment of the
- 18 anatomical structures that attach to the human foot.
- 19 (2) "Practice podiatry" does not include:
- 20 (i) [Triple arthrodesis, ankle fusions, or surgical] SURGICAL
- 21 treatment of ACUTE ankle [trauma] FRACTURE; or
- 22 (ii) Administration of an anesthetic, other than a local anesthetic.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 1997.
