A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - Salary Schedules by**  
3 **Jurisdiction**  
4 **MC/PG 47-97**

5 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning  
6 Commission (MNCPPC) to establish a separate schedule establishing the rates of  
7 compensation or salary levels for certain employees whose primary duties are  
8 performed in Montgomery County, Prince George's County, or equally divided  
9 between Montgomery and Prince George's Counties; and generally relating to the  
10 compensation of MNCPPC employees.

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
12 Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission  
13 Section 2-107  
14 Annotated Code of Maryland  
15 (1993 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission**

19 2-107.

20 (A) [The] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE Commission  
21 may appoint, fix the compensation of, or contract for the services of planning,  
22 engineering, administrative, auditing, clerical or other employees necessary for the  
23 administration of this article on a regional basis.

24 (B) THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH A SEPARATE SCHEDULE  
25 ESTABLISHING THE RATES OF COMPENSATION OR SALARY LEVELS FOR  
26 COMMISSION EMPLOYEES WHOSE PRIMARY DUTIES ARE PERFORMED:

27 (1) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY;

28 (2) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY; OR

1                   (3) EQUALLY DIVIDED BETWEEN MONTGOMERY AND PRINCE  
2 GEORGE'S COUNTIES.

3                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
4 October 1, 1997.
