1 AN ACT concerning

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain motor vehicles purchased by the
- 5 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to be registered in a

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 17 Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

- 18 SUBTITLE 4. COMMISSION MOTOR VEHICLES.
- 19 5-401.
- 20 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, ANY MOTOR
- 21 VEHICLE PURCHASED BY THE COMMISSION SHALL:
- 22 (1) BE REGISTERED IN THE NAME OF THE COMMISSION;
- 23 (2) DISPLAY THE SEAL OF THE COMMISSION ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE
- 24 DRIVER'S DOOR AND THE FRONT PASSENGER DOOR; AND
- 25 (3) DISPLAY REGISTRATION PLATES FROM THE MOTOR VEHICLE
- 26 ADMINISTRATION THAT IDENTIFY THE VEHICLE AS A LOCAL GOVERNMENT
- 27 VEHICLE.

- 1 (B) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO UNMARKED POLICE 2 VEHICLES.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed
- 4 retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect all motor vehicles owned by
- 5 the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission as of October 1, 1997.
- 6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 1997.
