	(2) (I) IF CERTIFIED BY THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF PURCHASING MANAGEMENT, THE PROFESSIONAL STAFF MEMBER SHALL BE CERTIFIED AT A MINIMUM AS AN ACCREDITED PURCHASING PRACTITIONER.
	(II) IF CERTIFIED BY THE UNIVERSAL PUBLIC PURCHASING CERTIFICATION COUNCIL, THE PROFESSIONAL STAFF MEMBER SHALL BE CERTIFIED AT A MINIMUM AS A CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL PUBLIC BUYER.
