15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 29 - Washington Suburban Sanitary District**

19 (a) (1) The WSSC may adopt rules and regulations that the WSSC considers
20 necessary or desirable for the construction, installation, and equipment of gas fixtures,
21 devices, and connections from the outlet of the meter supplying any building in the
22 [Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District] WASHINGTON SUBURBAN SANITARY

1 ~~DISTRICT OR ELSEWHERE IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.~~ The WSSC may require a
2 permit and charge a fee for these gas fixtures, devices, and connections.

3 (2) The WSSC shall publish separate notices of any new rules and
4 regulations which are authorized by this section at least 30 days before their effective date
5 in at least 2 newspapers published in each county.

6 (b) A person may not violate any of the rules or regulations adopted by the WSSC
7 under this section.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 1997.
