5 FOR the purpose of altering the boundaries of the school board districts for the election of members to the Board of Education for Montgomery County and for the election of the members to the Board of Education for Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
4 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(1) 5 elected members, each of whom resides in a different board of
(2) 2 elected members who may reside anywhere in the county; and

(c) An elected member of the County Board shall be a registered voter of
(d) Members of the Montgomery County Board shall be elected at the general election every 2 years as required by subsection (f) of this section.
(e) (1) The student member shall be a bona fide resident of Montgomery County and a regularly enrolled junior or senior year student from a Montgomery County
(2) The nomination and election process shall be as agreed on by the County Board and the Montgomery County region of the Maryland Association of Student Councils. This agreement shall include a process by which to replace one or both of the final candidates if they are unable to proceed in the election. Any student enrolled in grades 7 through 12 in the Montgomery County public schools may:
member if there are 3 or more candidates; and
(iii) Vote directly for 1 of the 2 remaining student Board member
(3) The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes in the direct election shall become the alternate student member. The alternate shall serve if the student member is unable to complete his elected term.
(4) Except as provided in paragraphs (5), (6), and (7) of this subsection, the student member has the same rights and privileges of an elected member.
(5) Unless invited to attend by the affirmative vote of a majority of the County Board, the student member may not attend an executive session that relates to:
(i) Hearings held under §6-202(a) of this article; or
(ii) Collective bargaining.
(6) As provided in paragraph (7) of this subsection, the student member shall vote on all matters except those relating to:
(i) § 6-202(a) of this article;
(ii) Collective bargaining;
(iii) Capital and operating budgets; and 3 on a case by case basis, whether a matter under consideration is covered by the 4 exclusionary provisions listed in paragraph (6) of this subsection. 8 serving on the County Board as of July 1, 1978 so that 4 members are elected in 9 gubernatorial election years and 3 members are elected in presidential election years. 11 the entire county.
(vii) Board of Education District 4 consists of Precincts 4 and 14 in 4 Election District 5; and Precincts $1,2,4,5,6,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,17,18,19,20,21$, $522,23,24,25,28,29,30,31,32,33,36,41,42,44,47,48,50,53,55,56,57,58,59$, [and] 6 63, 67, AND 68 in Election District 13.
(viii) Board of Education District 5 consists of Precinct 19 in Election 8 District 4; Precincts $1,2,3,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,15,16,17,18,19$, and 20 in Election
9 District 5; Precincts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 in Election District 8; Precincts 4 and 1014 in Election District 9; and Precincts 46, 49, 54, and 64 in Election District 13.
(4) (i) The student member serves for a term of 1 year beginning on July 121 after his election.
(ii) The student member shall be replaced for the remainder of the 14 term by the alternate student member if the student member:

1. Resigns or otherwise is unable to complete the term; or
2. Is removed under the provisions of subsection (g) of this 5 member a copy of the charges against him and give him an opportunity within 10 days to 6 request a hearing. 9 may not be set within 10 days after the County Council sends the member a notice of the 10 hearing; and
(ii) The member shall have an opportunity to be heard publicly before 12 the County Council in the member's own defense, in person or by counsel.

13 (4) A member removed under this subsection has the right to a de novo 14 review of the removal by the Circuit Court for Montgomery County.

16 (a) When the description of a school board district in this section refers to an 17 election district, it refers to the Prince George's County election district or precinct as 18 reviewed and certified by the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections 19 prior to their submission to the United States Bureau of the Census and on April 1, 1990.
(b) School board district I consists of:
(1) Election district 1, precincts 1 through 5;
(2) Election district 10 , precincts 1 through 10 ; and
(3) Election district 21, precincts 4, 5, and 14.
(c) School board district II consists of:
(1) Election district 14 , precincts 2 and 8 ;
(2) Election district 16, precincts 1 through 5;
(3) Election district 19, precincts 1 and 2; and
(4) Election district 21, precincts 1, 2, 3, and 6 through 13.
(d) School board district III consists of:
(1) Election district 17, precincts [1 through 15] 1, 2, 3, AND 5 THROUGH
(2) Election district 19, precinct 3; and
(3) Election district 21, precinct 15 .
(e) School board district IV consists of: 2 that runs along the center of the Ritchie Road spur from Ritchie Marlboro Road to 3 Ritchie Road.

(ii) That part of election district 15, precinct 2 that is north of a line that runs along the center of the Ritchie Road spur from Ritchie Marlboro Road to Ritchie Road.
(h) School board district VII consists of:
(1) Election district 6 , precincts 1,3 through $7,10,11,12,15$ through 19,21 ,
(2) Election district 9, precinct 3; and
(3) That part of election district 15 , precinct 2 that is generally south and west of a line that runs along the center of Washington Avenue from Darcy Road to Douglas Avenue, thence along the center of Douglas Avenue to Sansbury Road, thence along the center of Sansbury Road to Darcy Road.
(i) School board district VIII consists of:
(1) Election district 6 , precincts $2,8,9,13$, and 14 ; and
