## Boundaries

MC/PG 5-97

FOR the purpose of altering the boundaries of the school board districts for the election of members to the Board of Education for Montgomery County and for the election of the members to the Board of Education for Prince George's County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

6 3-901.
17 (a) In this subtitle, the following words have the meanings indicated:
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(1) "Elected member" means 1 of the 7 elected and voting members of the 19 Montgomery County Board or a member appointed to fill a vacancy of 1 of these 7
20 members.

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(2) "Board of Education District" means a geographic area of Montgomery

22 County in which an elected member of the Montgomery County Board of Education must
be a legal resident. The geographic area of each district is described in subsection (f) of
2 this section. Each district shall be substantially equal in population, and the districts shall
3 be reapportioned on the basis of each decennial census of the United States.
Reapportioned districts shall become effective for the term of office commencing after
5 the first regular primary election held at least 15 months after the official report on
6 population is received by the State from the Bureau of the Census. Montgomery County. public high school. candidates.
(2) 2 elected members who may reside anywhere in the county; and
(3) 1 student member.
(c) An elected member of the County Board shall be a registered voter of
(d) Members of the Montgomery County Board shall be elected at the general election every 2 years as required by subsection (f) of this section.
(e) (1) The student member shall be a bona fide resident of Montgomery County and a regularly enrolled junior or senior year student from a Montgomery County
(2) The nomination and election process shall be as agreed on by the County Board and the Montgomery County region of the Maryland Association of Student Councils. This agreement shall include a process by which to replace one or both of the final candidates if they are unable to proceed in the election. Any student enrolled in grades 7 through 12 in the Montgomery County public schools may:
(i) Nominate a student member candidate;
(ii) Vote for delegates from the student's school, who in turn vote in a nominating convention to reduce to 2 the number of candidates for student Board member if there are 3 or more candidates; and
(iii) Vote directly for 1 of the 2 remaining student Board member
(3) The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes in the direct election shall become the alternate student member. The alternate shall serve if the student member is unable to complete his elected term.
(4) Except as provided in paragraphs (5), (6), and (7) of this subsection, the student member has the same rights and privileges of an elected member.
(5) Unless invited to attend by the affirmative vote of a majority of the County Board, the student member may not attend an executive session that relates to:
(i) Hearings held under § 6-202(a) of this article; or
(ii) Collective bargaining. 18 shall reside in Board of Education District 2 and 1 shall reside in Board of Education 19 District 4 . The third member may reside in any part of the county.
(iv) Board of Education District 1 consists of all of Election Districts 1, 36 2, 3, 11, and 12; Precinct 3 in Election District 6; and Precincts 1, 2, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12,
37 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 26 in Election District 9. 7 24, 26, 27, 28, and 31 in Election District 4; all of Election District 7; Precincts 7 and 10 8 in Election District 10; and Precincts 3, 7, 16, 26, 27, 34, 38, 39, 40, and 62 in Election 9 District 13.
(vii) Board of Education District 4 consists of Precincts 4 and 14 in Election District 5; and Precincts $1,2,4,5,6,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,17,18,19,20,21$, $22,23,24,25,28,29,30,31,32,33,36,41,42,44,47,48,50,53,55,56,57,58,59$, [and] 63, 67, AND 68 in Election District 13.
(v) Board of Education District 2 consists of Precincts 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 9, $12,13,14,16,17,18,20,21,22,23,25,29,30,32$, and 33 in Election District 4; Precincts $1,2,4,5$, and 6 in Election District 6; Precincts 3, 6, 13, and 16 in Election District 9; Precincts $1,2,3,4,5,6,8,9,11,12$, and 13 in Election District 10; and Precincts 35, 37, $43,45,51,52$, and 60 in Election District 13.
(vi) Board of Education District 3 consists of Precincts 4, 8, 10, 11, 15,
(viii) Board of Education District 5 consists of Precinct 19 in Election District 4 ; Precincts $1,2,3,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,15,16,17,18,19$, and 20 in Election District 5; Precincts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 in Election District 8; Precincts 4 and 14 in Election District 9; and Precincts 46, 49, 54, and 64 in Election District 13. (4) (i) The student member serves for a term of 1 year beginning on July

1. Resigns or otherwise is unable to complete the term; or
2. Is removed under the provisions of subsection $(\mathrm{g})$ of this
(5) The remaining members of the County Board shall select a qualified individual to fill any vacancy on the elected Board for the remainder of that term and until a successor is elected and qualifies.
(6) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, an elected County Board member shall forfeit the office if the member fails to reside in the board of education district from which the member was elected.
(ii) If the failure to continue to reside in the district is caused by an alteration in the board of education district boundaries because of reapportionment, the member may complete the term for which the member was elected.

3 shall reside in the same district at the time of appointment and while filling out the 4 unexpired term.
(g) (1) The Montgomery County Council may remove a member of the County 6 Board for:
(i) Immorality;
(ii) Misconduct in office;
(iii) Incompetency; or
(iv) Willful neglect of duty.
(2) Before removing a member, the County Council shall provide the member a copy of the charges against him and give him an opportunity within 10 days to request a hearing.
(3) If the member requests a hearing within the 10-day period:
(i) The County Council promptly shall hold a hearing, but a hearing may not be set within 10 days after the County Council sends the member a notice of the hearing; and
(ii) The member shall have an opportunity to be heard publicly before the County Council in the member's own defense, in person or by counsel.
(4) A member removed under this subsection has the right to a de novo review of the removal by the Circuit Court for Montgomery County.
(a) When the description of a school board district in this section refers to an
(b) School board district I consists of:
(1) Election district 1, precincts 1 through 5;
(2) Election district 10 , precincts 1 through 10 ; and
(3) Election district 21, precincts 4, 5, and 14.
(c) School board district II consists of:
(1) Election district 14 , precincts 2 and 8 ;
(2) Election district 16 , precincts 1 through 5;
(3) Election district 19 , precincts 1 and 2; and
(4) Election district 21, precincts 1, 2, 3, and 6 through 13 .
(6) That part of election district 7, precinct 9 that is generally south and east of a line that runs along the center of the Northeast Branch from Central Avenue to the 4 western branch tributary, thence along the center of the western branch tributary to Old 5 Enterprise Road, thence along the center of Old Enterprise Road to Chesterton Drive, 36 thence along the center of Chesterton Drive to Blaketon Street, thence along the center 7 of Blaketon Street to Hunterton Street, thence along the center of Hunterton Street to

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Chesterton Drive, thence along the center of Chesterton Drive to Middleham Drive, thence along the center of Middleham Drive to West Branch Drive, thence along the center of West Branch Drive to Kettering Drive; and
(7) (i) That part of election district 15 , precinct 2 that is generally east of 5 a line that runs along the center of Ritchie Branch from Darcy Road to a point that is 6 generally east of the intersection of Ritchboro Road and Tulip Avenue; thence along an 7 imaginary line to Ritchboro Road; thence along the center of Ritchboro Road to Forest 8 Park Drive, thence along the center of Forest Park Drive to Ritchie Road; and
(ii) That part of election district 15, precinct 2 that is south of a line 0 that runs along the center of the Ritchie Road spur from Ritchie Marlboro Road to Ritchie Road.
(h) School board district VII consists of:
