SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

                   (3) The metropolitan district does not include an area that includes the City
   of Laurel as its municipal corporate boundaries existed on July 1, 1995 and begins at the

   intersection of the Patuxent River and the median of Interstate Route 95, then south
14 along Interstate Route 95 to the exact point where it intersects the Corporate Boundary
15 of the City of Laurel, at the point approximately 500 feet north of the intersection of
   Interstate Route 95 and Maryland Route 198, then directly southeast from the middle of
   this intersection which then coincides with Contee Road directly to the intersection of

18 Contee Road and Cherry Lane, then south and southeast along Contee Road to its
   intersection with U.S. Route 1 and the southern-most point of the corporate boundary of
20 the City of Laurel, then northeast, southeast, south, and east along the corporate
21 boundary of the City of Laurel, to the exact point where it intersects the Patuxent River,
22 then northeast, north, and northwest along the Patuxent River to its intersection with the
23 median of Interstate Route 95 1997.

            (b) The entire area of Prince George's County is within the regional district [,

   with the exception of the City of Laurel, as its corporate boundaries are defined as of July
31 1, 1994. A municipal corporation within the areas added by this subsection to the
32 Maryland-Washington Regional District is not authorized, by means of an amendment to
   its charter or otherwise, to exercise any of the powers relating to planning, subdivision
34 control, or zoning granted by the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning
35 Commission or the County Council of Prince George's County. If this subsection for any
36 reason is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, it is declared to be the
37 intention of the General Assembly that this subsection is severable and that the
38 remaining portions of this subsection would have been enacted without the invalid
39 portions].

- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 3-102(e) and
- 2 7-104 of Article 28 Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission of the
- 3 Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That nothing in this Act may be
- 5 construed as to affect the rights of any bondholder as of the effective date of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding the
- 7 provisions of Article 28 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Prince George's County may
- 8 not collect any delinquent Metropolitan District taxes owed but not levied before the
- 9 effective date of this Act under Article 28 of the Annotated Code of Maryland from those
- 10 persons who are residents of Election District 10, excluding public service companies.
- SECTION 3. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 July 1, 1997.
