19	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

Article 29 - Washington Suburban Sanitary District

- 3 (a) (1) (I) For the purpose of providing funds for the design, construction,
 4 reconstruction, establishment, extension, enlargement, purchase or condemnation of the
 5 water and sewerage systems in the sanitary district, or in any other areas where extension
 6 of any of [the aforementioned] THOSE systems may be authorized by law, or for the
 7 construction, remodeling, enlargement or replacement of any office or operating building
 8 or buildings required for the administration or operation of any of the systems, including
 9 the acquisition of land or equipment, the WSSC [is authorized and empowered to] MAY
 10 issue bonds of the sanitary district, from time to time, in such amounts as it may deem
 11 necessary to carry on its work[, but the].

 12 (II) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, FOR THE
 13 PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE ACQUISITION OR PURCHASE OF CAPITAL
 14 EQUIPMENT SUCH AS TRUCKS, FLEET VEHICLES, COMPUTERS, LABORATORY AND
- 15 MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT USED BY THE WSSC IN
 16 PROVIDING SERVICES TO CUSTOMERS INCLUDING MAINTENANCE FIELD AND YARD
 17 EQUIPMENT, TRUCKS, FLEET VEHICLES, COMPUTER EQUIPMENT,
 18 TELECOMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT, OFFICE EQUIPMENT, AND LABORATORY
- 19 <u>EQUIPMENT</u>, THE WSSC MAY ISSUE BONDS OF THE SANITARY DISTRICT, FROM TIME 20 TO TIME, IN SUCH AMOUNTS AS IT MAY DEEM NECESSARY TO CARRY ON ITS WORK.
- 21 (III) THE aggregate amount of bonds heretofore or hereafter issued 22 under this section which may be outstanding at any time, less the amount held in the joint
- 23 sinking fund account for the payment of the principal of the bonds, [shall] MAY not 24 exceed [14 percent] 14% of the total assessable basis of all property assessed for county
- 25 taxation purposes within the sanitary district; provided, however, that in computing the
- 23 taxation purposes within the saintary district, provided, nowever, that in computing the
- 26 amount of bonds which may be issued under this section, there [shall] MAY not be
- 27 included any bonds heretofore or hereafter issued for the payment of which the WSSC is
- 28 required by law to fix and collect water service charges at least sufficient to pay the
- 29 principal and interest requirements of such bonds.
- 30 (IV) Bonds hereafter issued under [the authority of] this section shall
- 31 be serial bonds with the principal of any given issue payable annually, commencing not
- $32\,$ more than 3 years from the date of ISSUE OF the bonds.
- 33 (V) The bonds may be either registered or coupon bonds, or
- 34 registerable as to principal with interest represented by coupons and issued in such
- 35 denomination or denominations as shall be determined by the WSSC, shall bear interest
- 36 as provided in § 4-104 of this title payable semi-annually and shall mature [not
- 37 exceeding] NO LATER THAN 40 years [from] AFTER the date of issue[, and all] OF
- 38 THE BONDS.
- 39 (VI) ALL bonds of the sanitary district or of the WSSC, including those
- 40 heretofore issued, shall be forever exempt from taxation by the State of Maryland and by
- 41 the counties and municipalities in the State.
- 42 (VII) Any bonds hereafter issued by the WSSC in its name or in the
- 43 name of the sanitary district may be made redeemable before maturity at the option of

- 1 the WSSC, at such price or prices and under such terms and conditions as may be fixed by 2 the WSSC prior to the issuance of such bonds.
- 3 (E) AS TO BONDS ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1)(II) OF THIS SECTION, IN 4 ADDITION TO THE CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS 5 SECTION:
- 6 (1) THE BONDS MAY BE ISSUED ONLY TO FINANCE THE ACQUISITION 7 OR PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT WITH A USEFUL LIFE OF 4 TO 7 YEARS, THAT WSSC
- 8 EXPECTS TO FINANCE OVER A PERIOD OF 4 YEARS OR LESS, AND FOR WHICH WSSC
- 9 SHALL BUDGET ACCORDINGLY;
- 10 (2) THE PRINCIPAL OF ANY GIVEN BOND ISSUE SHALL BE PAYABLE
 11 ANNUALLY STARTING NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUE OF THE
 12 BONDS;
- 13 (3) THE BONDS SHALL MATURE NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS AFTER THE 14 DATE OF ISSUE OF THE BONDS; AND
- 15 (4) THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF BONDS OUTSTANDING AT ANY TIME
- 16 MAY NOT EXCEED \$15,000,000, SUBJECT TO ANNUAL UPWARD ADJUSTMENT IN
- 17 ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX ALL URBAN CONSUMERS
- 18 (CPI-U), FOR THE WASHINGTON, DC-MD-VA METROPOLITAN AREA, OVER THE BASE
- 19 YEAR 1997.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 June 1, 1997.
