A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Kent County - County Treasurer - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of raising the salary of the County Treasurer of Kent County; providing
4 that this Act shall not be construed to apply to the salary of the incumbent official
5 but shall take effect at the beginning of the next term of office; and generally
6 relating to the salary of the County Treasurer of Kent County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 25 - County Commissioners**

15 51.

16 (t) (1) The ANNUAL SALARY OF THE County Treasurer of Kent County [shall
17 receive an annual salary of \$40,000] IS:

18 (I) \$45,000 FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1999;

19 (II) \$46,000 FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2000;

20 (III) \$47,000 FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2001; AND

21 (IV) \$48,000 FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2002 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT
22 CALENDAR YEAR.

23 (2) This money shall be the sole compensation for services performed by
24 him of any character whatever, including his capacity as a tax collector and issuer of
25 licenses. Any fees, commissions or other compensation paid to the County Treasurer
26 pursuant to any other laws of Kent County or the State of Maryland shall be accounted
27 for by the County Treasurer and paid into the general funds of Kent County.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
29 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or

1 apply to the salary or compensation of the County Treasurer of Kent County in office on
2 the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
3 compensation of the County Treasurer of Kent County shall take effect at the beginning
4 of the next following term of office.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 1997.
