- 26 WHEREAS, The Prince George's County budget is in need of significant
- 27 increases in revenue to provide adequate levels of services to County residents;
- 28 WHEREAS, Prince George's County government is prohibited by TRIM from
- 29 raising tax revenue through an increase in property taxes;

WHEREAS, It is critical to the financial well-being of Prince George's County that 2 all forms of current tax revenue be maintained; now, therefore, SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 4 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 5 Chapter 700 of the Acts of 1987, as amended by Chapter 244 of the Acts of 1989, Chapter 6 174 of the Acts of 1990, Chapter 565 of the Acts of 1992, Chapter 576 of the Acts of 1993, 7 and Chapter 65 of the Acts of 1995 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 July 1, 1987. [It shall remain effective for a period of 10 years and, at the end of June 30, 10 1997, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be 11 abrogated and of no further force and effect.] 12 Chapter 557 of the Acts of 1995 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Article 27, § 258B(c) and 13 14 (d) and § 2-309(r)(8)(vi) of Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article as enacted by Section 15 1 of this Act shall remain effective [for a period of 2 years from the effective date of the 16 Act, and at the end of 2 years] UNTIL JULY 1, 1999, AT WHICH TIME, with no further 17 action required by the General Assembly, Article 27, § 258B(c) and (d) and § 18 2-309(r)(8)(vi) of Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article of the Code as enacted by 19 Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. **Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments** 20 21 258B. 22 (c) (8) On or before [July 1] OCTOBER 1 of each year, each person, group, or 23 organization operating as a casino night permittee pursuant to this subsection during the 24 [12 months preceding that July 1] PERIOD BETWEEN JULY 1 OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR 25 THROUGH JUNE 30 OF THE CURRENT YEAR shall report under affidavit to the 26 Comptroller of the Treasury, the County Executive and County Council of Prince 27 George's County, and the Prince George's County House and Senate Delegations on: (i) The total gross receipts from gaming activities at casino nights in 29 Prince George's County for the 12-month period BETWEEN JULY 1 OF THE PREVIOUS 30 YEAR THROUGH JUNE 30 OF THE CURRENT YEAR; and 31 (ii) The total expenses directly relating to gaming activities at casino 32 nights for the 12-month period.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
