2 **Montgomery County - Sediment Control Plans**
3 **MC 729-97**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the authority of the soil conservation district in Montgomery
5 County to delegate certain functions to the Montgomery County Department of
6 Environmental Protection so as to provide that the soil conservation district may
7 delegate the functions to the Montgomery County government by a certain written
8 agreement; and generally relating to the authority to review and approve or reject
9 sediment control plans in Montgomery County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 (b) In Montgomery County, notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (c) of
20 this section and § 4-103(a)(1) of this subtitle, the soil conservation district may delegate
21 [to the County Department of Environmental Protection, by written agreement between
22 the district and the County Department of Environmental Protection,] the authority to
23 review and approve or reject any sediment control plans for nonagricultural construction

1 TO THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY GOVERNMENT BY WRITTEN AGREEMENT BETWEEN
2 THE DISTRICT AND THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENT AUTHORIZED BY
3 COUNTY LAW OR REGULATION TO PERFORM THOSE FUNCTIONS.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 June 1, 1997.
