1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Bowling Alleys - Class H Beer and Wine)**
4 **MC 731-97**

5 FOR the purpose of deleting bowling alleys in Montgomery County from the prohibition
6 on holding Class H beer and light wine alcoholic beverages licenses; and generally
7 relating to alcoholic beverages in Montgomery County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 5-202.

17 (c) (2) (i) This paragraph applies only in Montgomery County.

18 (ii) A license may not be issued to, or for use in conjunction with, or
19 upon the premises of any restaurant located within a [bowling alley or] drugstore or for
20 use upon any premises which has a door, archway, opening or other passageway providing
21 direct public access to any [bowling alley or] drugstore.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 1997.
