A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Micro-Brewery Licenses - Class H Beer and Light Wine)**
4 **MC 733-97**

5 FOR the purpose of including Class H beer and light wine licensees in Montgomery
6 County among those who may be issued a micro-brewery license by the Office of
7 the Comptroller; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Montgomery
8 County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
10 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
11 Section 2-208(b)
12 Annotated Code of Maryland
13 (1996 Replacement Volume)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

17 2-208.

18 (b) The license shall be issued:

19 (1) By the State Comptroller;

20 (2) Only in the following jurisdictions:

21 (i) Allegany County;

22 (ii) Baltimore City;

23 (iii) Baltimore County;

24 (iv) The City of Annapolis;

25 (v) Anne Arundel County;

26 (vi) The thirteenth election district of Carroll County;

- 1 (vii) Charles County;
- 2 (viii) Dorchester County;
- 3 (ix) Frederick County;
- 4 (x) Garrett County;
- 5 (xi) Howard County;
- 6 (xii) Montgomery County; and
- 7 (xiii) Prince George's County; [and]

8 (3) (i) Only to a holder of a Class B beer, wine and liquor (on-sale)
9 license that is issued for use on the premises of a restaurant located in a jurisdiction listed
10 in paragraph (2) of this subsection; or

11 (ii) To a holder of a Class D alcoholic beverages license that is issued
12 for use on the premises of the existing Class D license if the premises are located in the
13 22nd Alcoholic Beverages District of Prince George's County; AND

14 (4) IN ADDITION TO ITEM (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IN MONTGOMERY
15 COUNTY ONLY TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS H BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE THAT IS
16 ISSUED FOR USE ON THE PREMISES OF A RESTAURANT LOCATED IN THE COUNTY.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 1997.
