27 28	(4) In compliance with the rules and regulations adopted by the Board under this section.
31	(i) Subject to the Administrative Procedure Act, the Board may suspend or revoke the home [hemodialysis] DIALYSIS distribution permit of any home [hemodialysis] DIALYSIS distribution permit holder who fails to comply with subsection (h) of this section.
