- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 14 **Article - Education**

- 16 (c) (1) In Montgomery [and Prince George's Counties] COUNTY, PRINCE
- 17 GEORGE'S COUNTY, BALTIMORE COUNTY, and Baltimore City, the public school
- 18 employer may negotiate with the employee organization designated as the exclusive
- 19 representative for the public school employees in a unit, a reasonable service or
- 20 representation fee, to be charged nonmembers for representing them in negotiations,
- 21 contract administration, including grievances, and other activities as are required under
- 22 subsection (b) of this section.
- 23 (2) The service or representation fee may not exceed the annual dues of the
- 24 members of the organization.
- 25 (3) An employee who is a substitute teacher and who works on a short-term
- 26 day-to-day basis is not required to pay a service or representation fee.
- 27 (4) An employee whose religious beliefs are opposed to joining or
- 28 financially supporting any collective bargaining organization is:
- 29 (i) Not required to pay a service or representation fee; and

- 1 (ii) Required to pay an amount of money as determined in [subsection
- 2 (c)(2)] PARAGRAPH (2) of this [section] SUBSECTION to a nonreligious, nonunion
- 3 charity or to such other charitable organization as may be mutually agreed upon by the
- 4 employee and the exclusive representative, and who furnishes to the public school
- 5 employer and the exclusive representative written proof of such payment.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 July 1, 1997.
