BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 12 **Article - Environment** 13 2-301. 14 (a) The Department: 15 (1) May adopt rules and regulations for the control of air pollution in this 16 State, including testing, monitoring, recordkeeping, and reporting requirements; and 17 (2) Shall adopt rules and regulations that establish standards and 18 procedures to be followed whenever pollution of the air reaches an emergency condition. 19 (b) In adopting any rule or regulation under this title, the Department shall 20 consider, among other things: 21 (1) The residential, commercial, or industrial nature of the area affected; 22 (2) Zoning; 23 (3) The nature and source of various kinds of air pollution; 24 (4) The problems of any commercial or industrial establishment that may be

- 1 (c) Any rule or regulation adopted under this title that relates to grain drying
- 2 operations shall be adopted with the advice and consent of the State Department of

- 5 BASED ON A RECOMMENDATION BY THE OZONE TRANSPORT ASSESSMENT GROUP
- 6 MAY NOT BE ADOPTED UNLESS THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SPECIFICALLY
- 7 AUTHORIZES, BY STATUTE, THE PROPOSED RULE OR REGULATION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
