- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the sale of certain refrigerated foods after certain dates
- 4 under certain circumstances; providing penalties for violations of this Act; defining
- 5 a term; and generally relating to the prohibition of the sale of refrigerated foods
- 6 beyond certain dates.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Health General
- 15 21-214.
- 16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "REFRIGERATED FOOD" MEANS ANY FOOD THAT MUST 17 BE REFRIGERATED TO PRESERVE THE FOOD FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION AT A 18 LATER TIME.
- 19 (B) (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON MAY NOT 20 SELL ANY REFRIGERATED FOOD:
- 21 (I) AFTER A SELL-BY DATE ASSOCIATED WITH THAT FOOD; OR
- 22 (II) AFTER 7 DAYS AFTER A USE-BY DATE ASSOCIATED WITH THAT
- 23 FOOD.
- 24 (2) IF A REFRIGERATED FOOD PRODUCT HAS A SELL-BY DATE AND A
- 25 USE-BY DATE, A PERSON MAY NOT SELL THE REFRIGERATED FOOD AFTER 7 DAYS
- 26 AFTER THE USE-BY DATE.

- 1 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 2 AND IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$500 FOR EACH DAY OR PART OF A DAY
- 3 THAT A VIOLATION CONTINUES.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 October 1, 1997.
