## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Vehicle Laws - Alcohol and Drug Related Driving Offenses - "DUI" Registration Plates

FOR the purpose of allowing the Motor Vehicle Administration to recall the registration plates assigned to a vehicle owned by a person who is convicted of certain alcohol and drug related driving offenses and issue for the vehicle special DUI registration plates; providing for the design of DUI registration plates; requiring the Administration to provide a certain notice to an owner whose registration plates have been recalled and requiring the owner to comply with the notice within a certain period; requiring the owner of a vehicle assigned DUI registration plates to pay a certain fee determined by the Administration; limiting the amount of the fee; requiring DUI registration plates issued for a vehicle to be displayed on the vehicle for a certain period; providing for the return of the regular registration plates to the vehicle owner or the issuance of new registration plates and validation tabs under certain circumstances; requiring the owner of a vehicle displaying DUI registration plates to maintain the vehicle's registration as otherwise required by law; and generally relating to DUI registration plates.
