## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Vehicle Laws - Alcohol and Drug Related Driving Offenses - "DUI" Registration Plates

- 3 FOR the purpose of allowing the Motor Vehicle Administration to recall the registration
- 4 plates assigned to a vehicle owned by a person who is convicted of certain alcohol
- 5 and drug related driving offenses and issue for the vehicle special DUI registration
- 6 plates; providing for the design of DUI registration plates; requiring the
- Administration to provide a certain notice to an owner whose registration plates
- 8 have been recalled and requiring the owner to comply with the notice within a
- 9 certain period; requiring the owner of a vehicle assigned DUI registration plates to
- pay a certain fee determined by the Administration; limiting the amount of the fee;
- 11 requiring DUI registration plates issued for a vehicle to be displayed on the vehicle
- for a certain period; providing for the return of the regular registration plates to the
- vehicle owner or the issuance of new registration plates and validation tabs under
- 14 certain circumstances; requiring the owner of a vehicle displaying DUI registration
- 15 plates to maintain the vehicle's registration as otherwise required by law; and

- 27 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 28 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 (A) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ISSUE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS
- 4 SECTION SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES THAT IDENTIFY THE VEHICLE
- 5 DISPLAYING THE PLATES AS BEING OWNED BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS BEEN
- 6 CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF § 21-902 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 7 (2) SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION
- 8 SHALL BE OF A DISTINCTIVE DESIGN DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION AND

- 16 DATE OF THE NOTICE; AND

	(2) AT THE END OF THE PERIOD SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND UPON PAYMENT OF THE REGISTRATION FEE OTHERWISE REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:

15	(a) (1) A person may not drive or attempt to drive any vehicle while intoxicated.		
16 17	(2) A person may not drive or attempt to drive any vehicle while the person is intoxicated per se.		
	18 (b) A person may not drive or attempt to drive any vehicle while under the 19 influence of alcohol.		
21	20 (c) (1) A person may not drive or attempt to drive any vehicle while he is so far 21 under the influence of any drug, any combination of drugs, or a combination of one or 22 more drugs and alcohol that he cannot drive a vehicle safely.		
25 26	(2) It is not a defense to any charge of violating this subsection that the person charged is or was entitled under the laws of this State to use the drug, combination of drugs, or combination of one or more drugs and alcohol, unless the person was unaware that the drug or combination would make him incapable of safely driving a vehicle.		
30	(d) A person may not drive or attempt to drive any vehicle while he is under the influence of any controlled dangerous substance, as that term is defined in Article 27, § 279 of the Code, if the person is not entitled to use the controlled dangerous substance under the laws of this State.
