CHAPTER ____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - Orphans' Court Judges, State's Attorney, Treasurer, and Sheriff -**
3 **Salary Adjustments**

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the salaries of the State's Attorney, County Treasurer,
5 Sheriff, and Orphans' Court Judges for Frederick County; providing that this Act
6 may not be construed to increase or diminish the salary or compensation of the
7 incumbent or any future State's Attorney for Frederick County during the term of
8 office as State's Attorney; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or
9 compensation of the incumbent County Treasurer, Sheriff, and Orphans' Court
10 Judges for Frederick County during the terms of offices as County Treasurer,
11 Sheriff, and Orphans' Court Judges for Frederick County; and generally relating to
12 the salaries and compensation of public officials in Frederick County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 10 - Legal Officials**

18 40.

19 (a) The State's Attorneys in the several counties of the State shall receive
20 annually the respective salaries set forth for performing the duties required of them by
21 their respective public local laws and by the public general laws, and such expenses as are
22 provided by law and by the current practice in the several counties. The State's Attorneys
23 shall receive annual payments for office, traveling and other expenses. All payments for
24 salaries and expenses shall be made by the respective counties in equal monthly
25 installments unless otherwise specified. The salaries and expenses are as follows:

26 (k) (1) In Frederick County, the State's Attorney's annual salary [is \$52,000]
27 SHALL BE 80 PERCENT OF THE SALARY OF A JUDGE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF
28 MARYLAND.

29 **Article 25 - County Commissioners**

31 (m) In Frederick County the annual salary of the County Treasurer is [\$40,000]
32 \$50,000.

33 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

35 (l) (1) The Sheriff of Frederick County shall receive a salary of [\$40,000]
36 \$50,000. The Sheriff shall appoint deputies as necessary, at salaries of at least \$2,400, and
37 jail wardens as necessary, at salaries of at least \$1,320 each. The Sheriff also may appoint
38 additional temporary deputy sheriffs as the Sheriff considers necessary for the public

1 safety, with the approval of the Board of County Commissioners. The County
2 Commissioners shall allow reasonable compensation for the temporary additional deputy
3 sheriffs and the temporary deputies may not serve longer than the occasion requires. The
4 Sheriff may appoint a chief deputy who shall serve at the pleasure of the Sheriff.

5 **Article - Estates and Trusts**

7 (1) THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT FOR FREDERICK COUNTY SHALL
8 RECEIVE AN ANNUAL COMPENSATION OF \$6,500. Each of the ASSOCIATE judges of the
9 Court for Frederick County shall receive an annual compensation of [~~\$5,000~~] \$6,000.
10 Each judge also shall receive reimbursement for expenses actually incurred in the
11 performance of duties, up to \$700 per year, to be paid by the Board of County
12 Commissioners each month upon presentation of an itemized voucher.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
14 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to increase or
15 diminish the salary or compensation of the incumbent or any future State's Attorney for
16 Frederick County during the term of office of the State's Attorney for Frederick County.

17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
18 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
19 apply to the salaries or compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Frederick
20 County, the County Treasurer of Frederick County, and the Sheriff of Frederick County
21 in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
22 salaries or compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Frederick County, the
23 County Treasurer of Frederick County, and the Sheriff of Frederick County shall take
24 effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

25 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 1997.
