- 19 law, the Central Collection Unit is responsible for the collection of each delinquent
- 20 account or other debt that is owed to the State or any of its officials or units.

- 22 Collection Unit each debt for which the Central Collection Unit has collection
- 23 responsibility under this subsection and may not settle the debt.
