14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (f) (1) All revenues accruing to the Wildlife Management and Protection Fund
19 from sales of the migratory wild waterfowl stamps shall be expended solely for the
20 following purposes:
21 (i) Waterfowl projects included in an approved State program to
22 create, develop, enhance, maintain, and manage nesting cover, winter foods, and other
23 habitat components on public lands to satisfy the habitat requirements of a broad range
24 of wintering waterfowl and native waterfowl species; and

1 (ii) Not more than 30% to adopt and implement a program to
2 eradicate the species Myocastor coypu (nutria) and to control the species Phragmites
3 communis (phragmites) on private lands.
4 (2) To encourage waterfowl habitat conservation on private lands, the
5 Department shall implement a 10-year licensing agreement for approved projects on
6 privately owned lands detailing the landowner's responsibilities. Expenditures by private
7 landowners on private land for these waterfowl projects approved by the Department and
8 covered by the licensing agreement shall be considered a contribution to the State.
