- 6 delivered in a shopping cart; providing a penalty for a violation of this Act; and

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 27 (A) A PERSON LICENSED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT RECEIVE ANY
- 28 SCRAP METAL DELIVERED TO THAT PERSON IN A SHOPPING CART.

- 1 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT 2 TO A CIVIL FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

- 10 (A) A PERSON LICENSED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT RECEIVE ANY 11 SCRAP METAL DELIVERED TO THAT PERSON IN A SHOPPING CART.
- 12 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT 13 TO A CIVIL FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
