A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Prohibition of HOV Lanes on State Highways

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State Highway Administration from designating any

- 4 portion of a State highway as a high occupancy vehicle (HOV) lane, the use of
- 5 which is restricted to vehicles carrying a specified number of passengers; and
- 6 generally relating to a prohibition against HOV lanes on State highways.

7 BY adding to

- 9 Section 8-601.2
- 10 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 11 (1993 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article - Transportation

15 8-601.2.

16 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE ADMINISTRATION
17 MAY NOT DESIGNATE ANY PORTION OF A STATE HIGHWAY AS A HIGH OCCUPANCY
18 VEHICLE (HOV) LANE, THE USE OF WHICH IS RESTRICTED TO VEHICLES CARRYING
19 A SPECIFIED NUMBER OF PASSENGERS.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 1997.
