12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

16 (b-3) [(1)] A Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or beer, wine and liquor

17 license may not be issued except by way of renewal [in Baltimore City] to a person,

- 18 corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverage license in any
- 19 other state OR WASHINGTON, D.C.

20 [(2) A Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or beer, wine and liquor

21 license may not be issued except by way of renewal in Anne Arundel County to a person,

22 corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverage license in any

23 other state, or Washington, D.C.]

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 October 1, 1997.
