- **3 Offset for Workers' Compensation Benefits Exclusion**
- 4 FOR the purpose of providing that a retiree who receives a disability retirement benefit
- 5 as a former employee of a county board of education or the Board of School
- 6 Commissioners of Baltimore City or a designated beneficiary of the retiree is not
- 7 subject to an offset of those benefits under a certain provision of the Code due to
- 8 receipt of workers' compensation benefits; providing that the retiree or designated
- 9 beneficiary is subject to an offset of the workers' compensation benefits under a
- 10 certain provision of the Code; and generally relating to the offset of benefits of a
- 11 retiree who receives a disability retirement benefit as a former employee of a county

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article State Personnel and Pensions

- 22 (a) (1) [This] EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION,
- 23 THIS section applies to a retiree and any designated beneficiary.
- 24 (2) (I) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A RETIREE WHO RECEIVES
- 25 A DISABILITY RETIREMENT BENEFIT AS A FORMER EMPLOYEE OF A COUNTY
- 26 BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE
